<p>Rainbow Writing</p> <p>First write each word in pencil. Then trace over each word three times. Each time you trace, you must use a different color crayon. Trace neatly and you will see a rainbow!</p>	<p>I SPY a Word</p> <p>Draw and color a picture. Hide your spelling words inside your picture. Show your picture to someone and see if they can find your words.</p>	<p>Backwards Words</p> <p>Write your spelling words forwards and backwards. Write neatly.</p> <p>Example: where erhew</p>	<p>Silly Sentences</p> <p>Write silly sentence using a spelling word in each sentence. Please underline your spelling word! Write neatly!</p> <p>Example: My dog wears a <u>blue</u> and <u>purple</u> dress <u>when</u> he takes a bath.</p>												
<p>Pyramid Writing</p> <p>"Pyramid write" your spelling words. You must write neatly!</p> <p>Example: home</p> <p style="text-align: center;">h ho hom home</p>	<p>ABC Order</p> <p>First write your spelling words in a list. Then write them in ABC order.</p> <p>For an extra bonus: underline all the silent letters.</p>	<p>Story, Story</p> <p>Write a story using all of your spelling words. Be sure to underline your spelling words in your paragraph.</p> <p>Bonus: You may want to type your story.</p>	<p>Blue Vowels</p> <p>Write each of your spelling words. You will need a blue crayon. Trace over the vowels in each word with your blue crayon.</p> <p>Vowels: a e i o u and sometimes y</p>												
<p>Bubble Letters</p> <p>Write your spelling words in bubble letters. After you write your words in bubble letters, color your words in with a crayon.</p> <p>Bubble Letters Rock!</p>	<p>Spelling Shapes</p> <p>Count your spelling words. Draw one shape for each word. Then write your spelling words inside each of the shapes.</p> <p>Examples:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> babies cried </p>	<p>Scrambled Words</p> <p>Fold a piece of paper 3 times lengthwise. (Making 3 long rectangular columns). Write your words in the first column. Then write them again with the letters all mixed up (scrambled) in the second column. Unscramble the words in the last column.</p>	<p>Riddle Me</p> <p>Write a riddle for each of your spelling words. Don't forget to add the answers to your riddles.</p> <p>Example: I cry when I am hungry. I wear diapers. I am cute and soft. What am I? *Answer- A baby.</p>												
<p>Rhyming Words</p> <p>Write each of your spelling words. Next to each word, write a rhyming word. If necessary, your rhyming word can be a nonsense word (as long as it follows the same spelling pattern). Example: cries, tries</p>	<p>Adding My Words</p> <p>Each letter has a value. *Consonants are worth 10. *Vowels are worth 5.</p> <p>Write your spelling words. Then add up the value of each spelling word.</p> <p>Example: said-10+5+5+10=30</p>	<p>Telephone Words</p> <p>First write your words in a list. Then look at the keypad.
